ABOUT THE SHOW ...Long before she was Carole King, chart-topping music legend, she was Carol Klein, a Brooklyn girl with passion and chutzpah. She fought her way into the record business as a teenager and, by the time she reached her twenties, had the husband of her dreams and a flourishing career writing hits for the biggest acts in rock 'n' roll. But it wasn't until her personal life began to crack that she finally managed to find her true voice. *Beautiful: The Carole King Musical* tells the inspiring true story of King's remarkable rise to stardom, from being part of a hit songwriting team with her husband Gerry Goffin, to her relationship with fellow writers and best friends Cynthia Weil and Barry Mann, to becoming one of the most successful solo acts in popular music history. Along the way, she made more than beautiful music, she wrote the soundtrack to a generation. King wrote her first #1 hit-"Will you Still Love Me Tomorrow?" at age 17 with Goffin. While the pair wrote dozens of chart hits together, it was King's solo album "Tapestry" that took her to the pinnacle in 1971. To date, more than 400 of her songs have been recorded by 1,000 artists. Featuring a stunning array of beloved songs written by Gerry Goffin/Carole King and Barry Mann/ Cynthia Weil, including "I Feel The Earth Move," "One Fine Day," "(You Make Me Feel Like) A Natural Woman," "You've Got A Friend" and the title song, *Beautiful* has a book by Tony Award nominee and Academy Award-nominated writer Douglas McGrath, direction by Marc Bruni, choreography by Josh Prince and took home two 2014 Tony Awards and the 2015 Grammy for Best Musical Theater Album.
