Tom Berger's work as a director, music director, choreographer, and teaching artist has been seen all over the country in something like 400-odd productions. He has credits as varying as off-Broadway, national tours, major regional theatre, and educational productions with everything from high schools in the Bronx to Ivy League universities. Locally, Tom has worked with STC, Kiel Area Theatre, UW-Sheboygan, and the Sheboygan, Kewaunee, and Plymouth school districts, among others. He currently serves as Artistic Director of Seven Ages Theatricals, Creative Director of the new Manitowoc venue Parkview Playhouse, and an artistic consultant for Lakeshore Productions, Inc., where he'll return to (hopefully) direct and choreograph *The Wizard of Oz* in 2021. He lives in Sheboygan with his favorite production, the 10-year-old Sebastian.
