

CLASS OBJECTIVES:

JANUARY 22– Drawing still life (non-living objects) with emphasis on shapes, positive and negative space, measuring and proportions.

FEBRUARY 19- Exploring shading and texture to capture how light, colors and patterns can create depth and the illusion of surface quality.



MARCH 19– Understanding perspective in drawing to represent three dimensional objects on a flat surface, creating the illusion of depth by making objects appear smaller as they move further away from the viewer.
